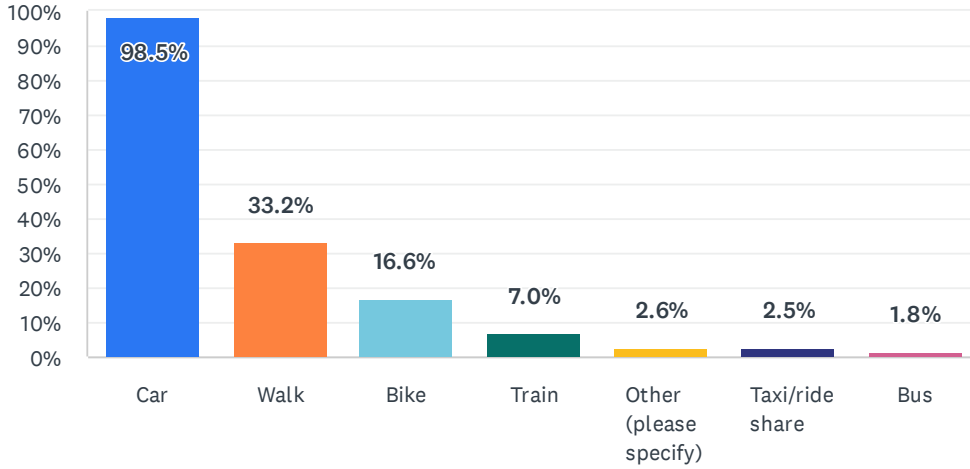


Q1 What forms of transportation do you use on a regular basis (at least once a week)? Check all that apply.

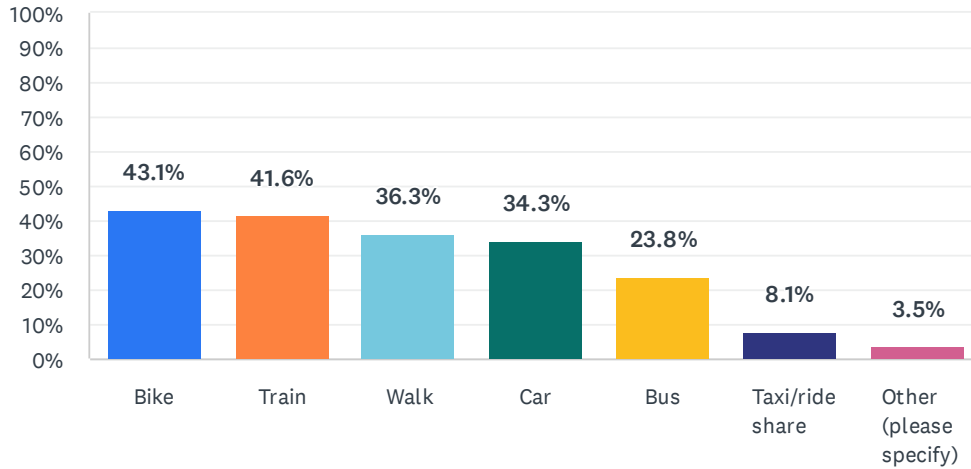

Q2 If they were improved, what forms of transportation would you like to use more? Check all that apply.

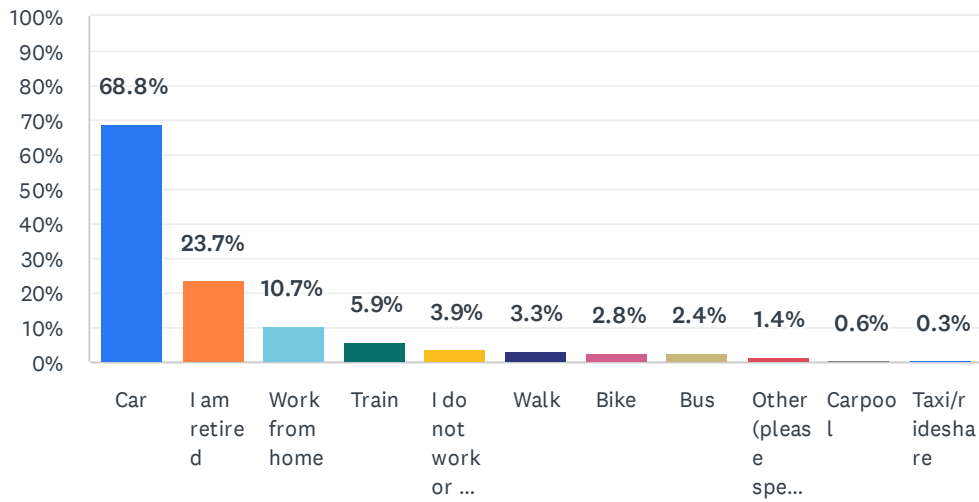

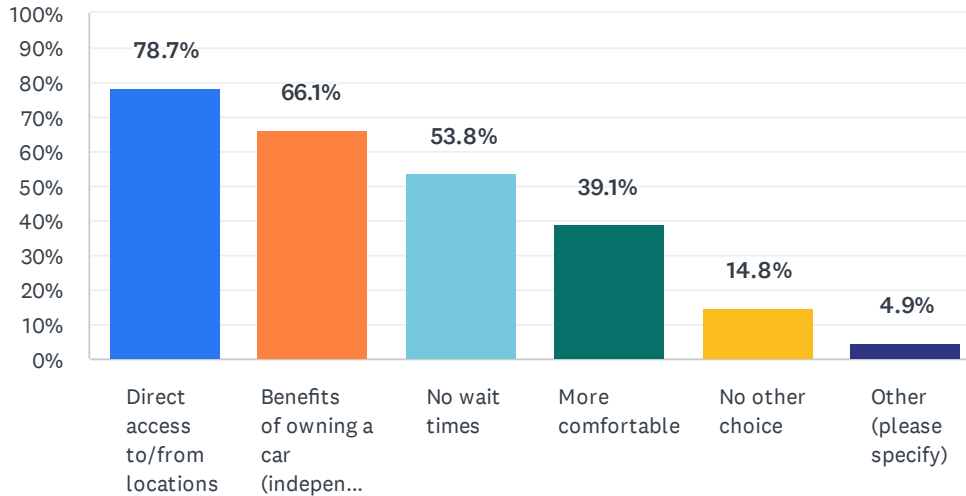

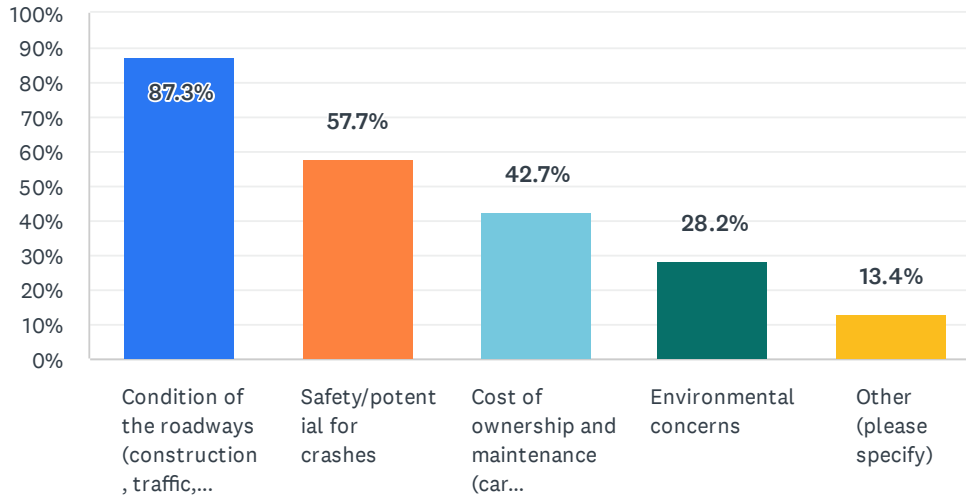

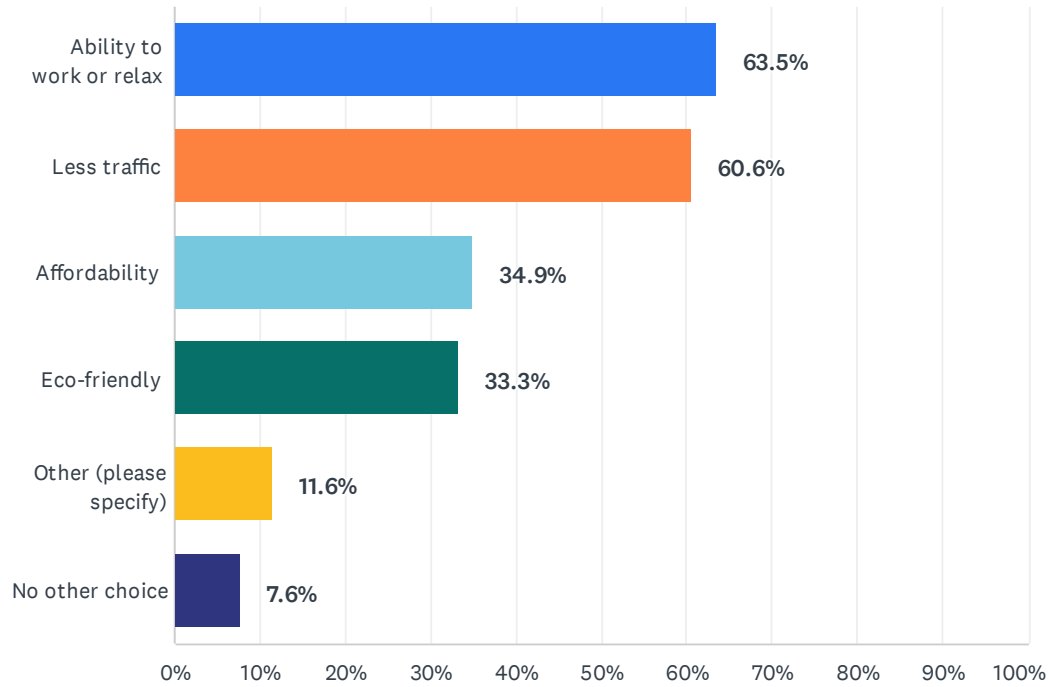

Q6 What makes taking the train (for commuting or recreation) easy? Check all that apply.

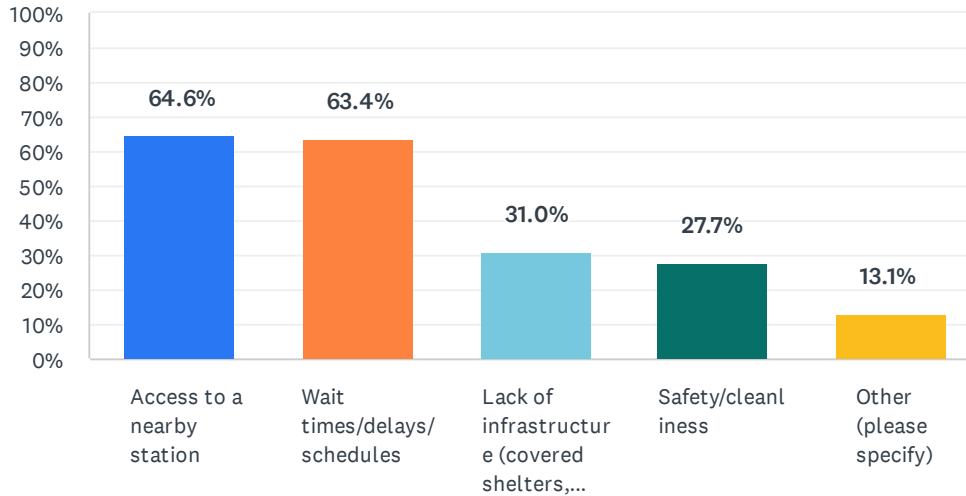

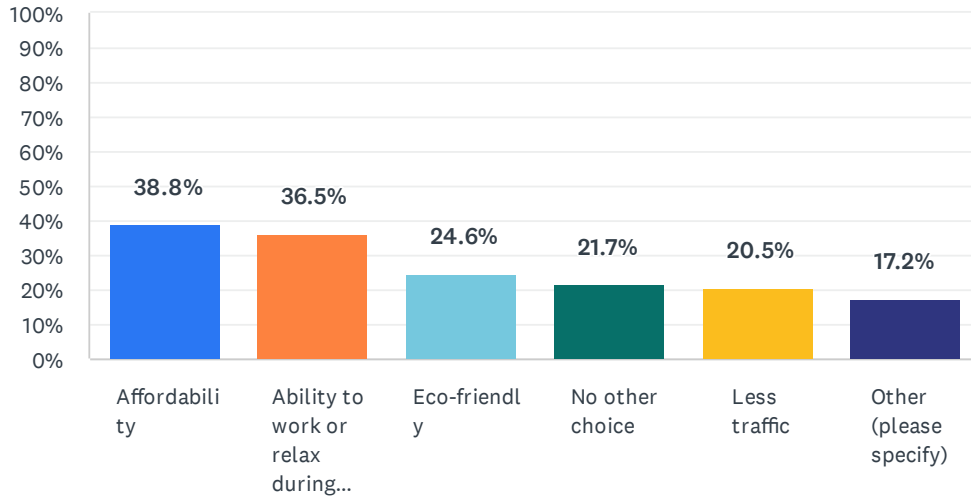

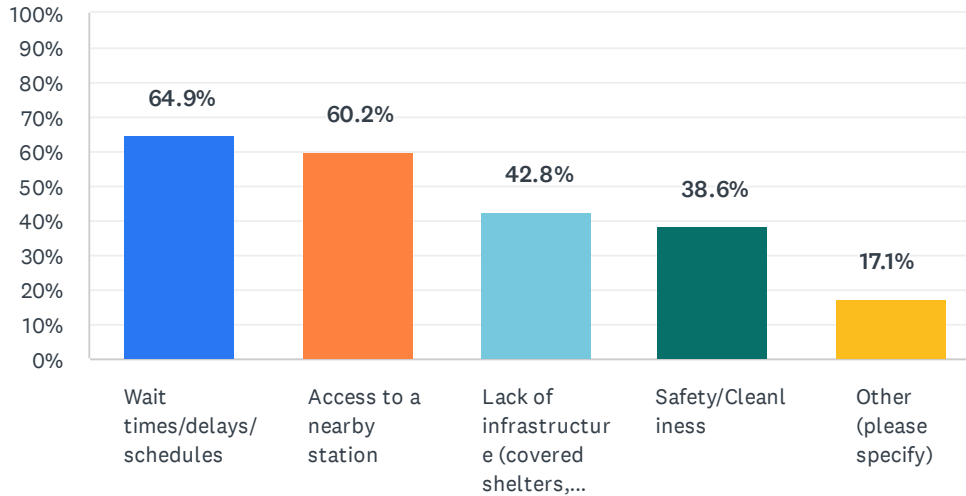

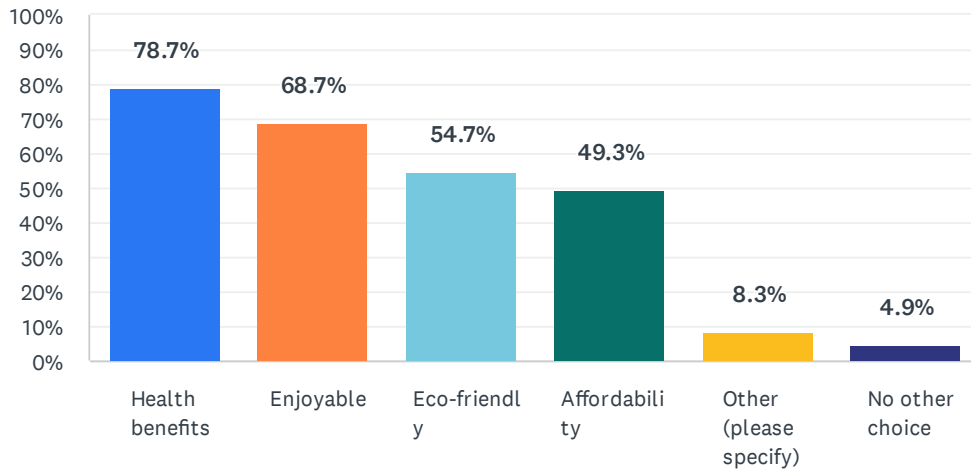

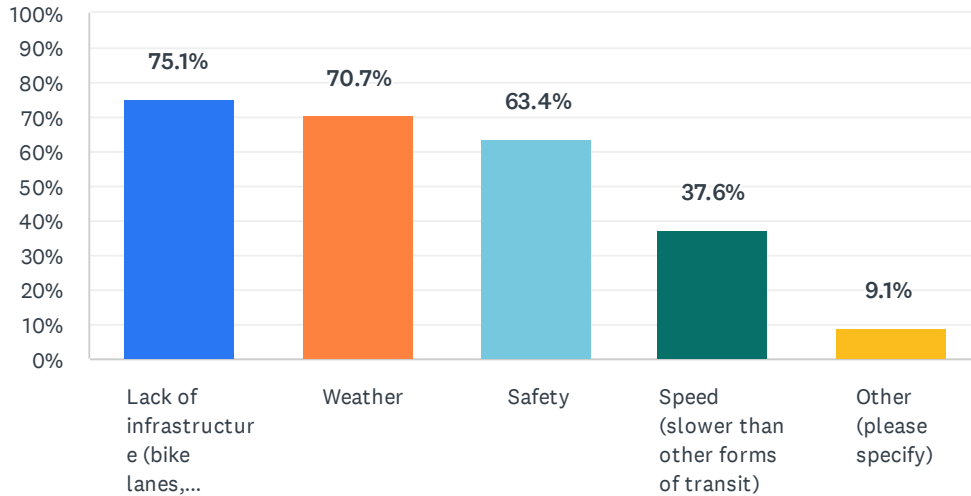

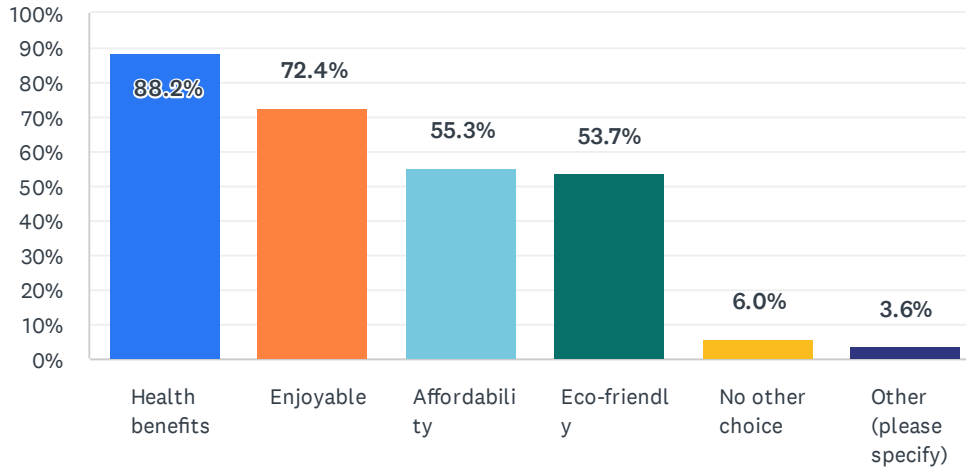

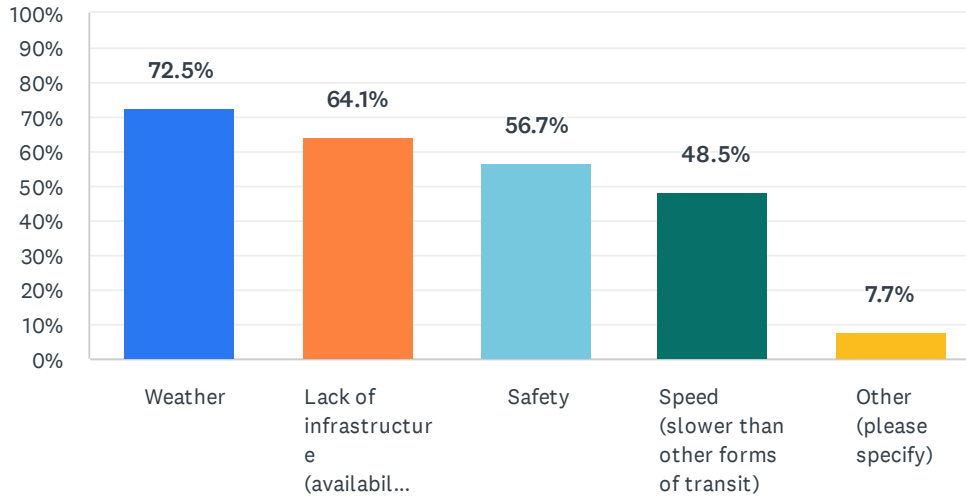

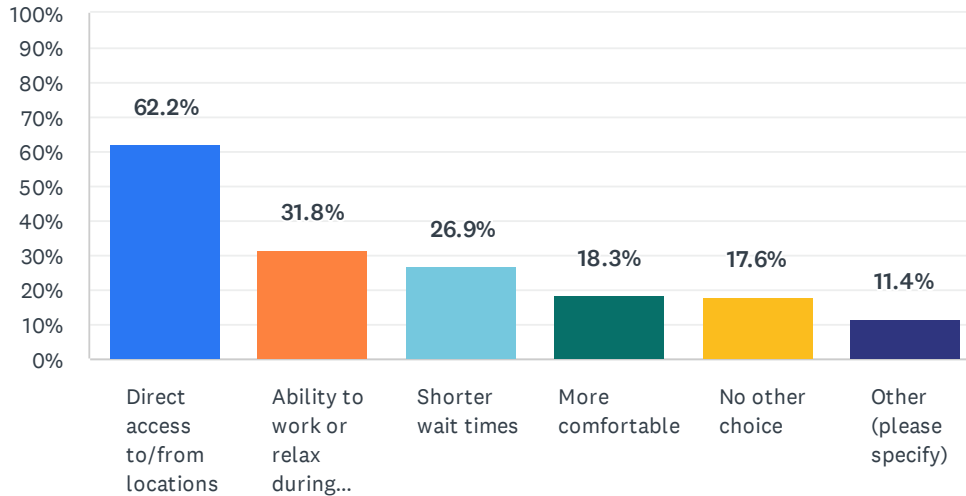

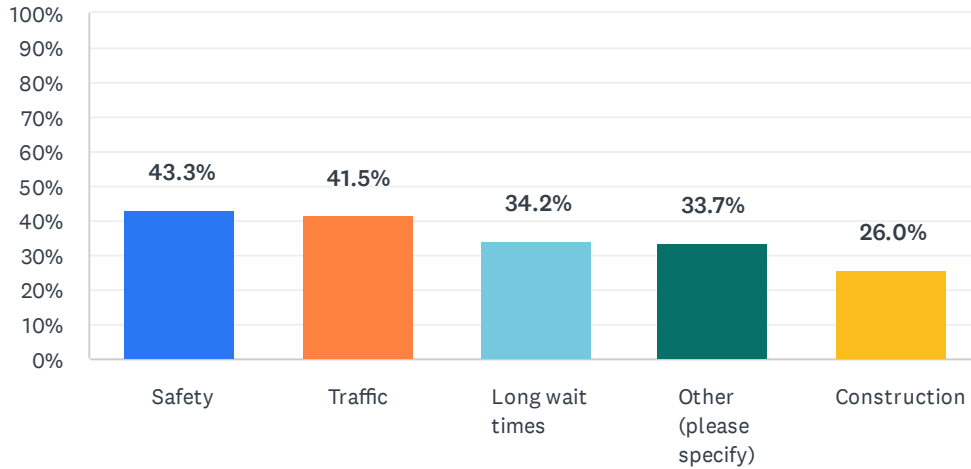

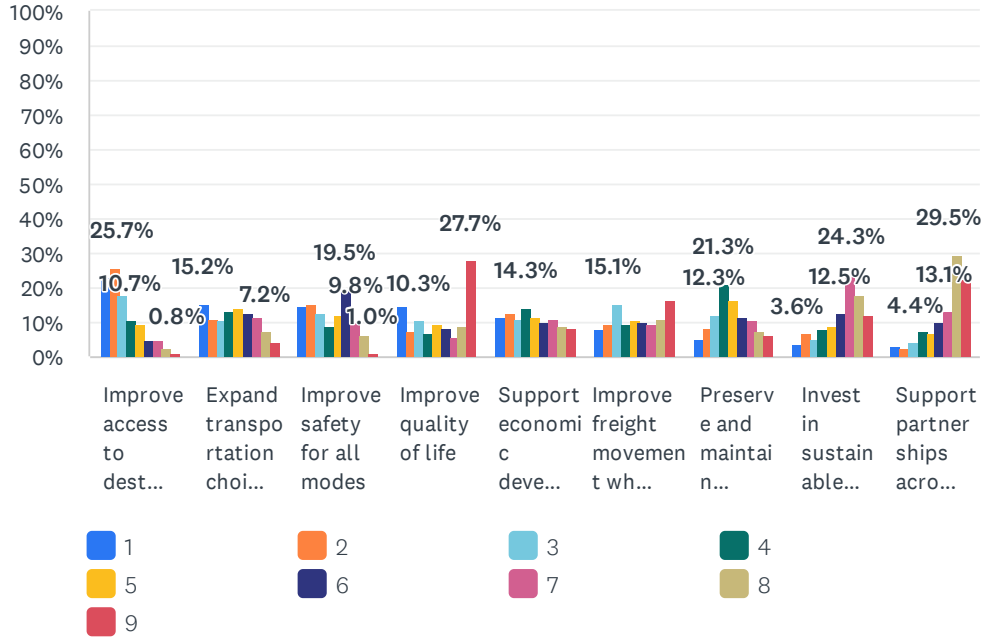

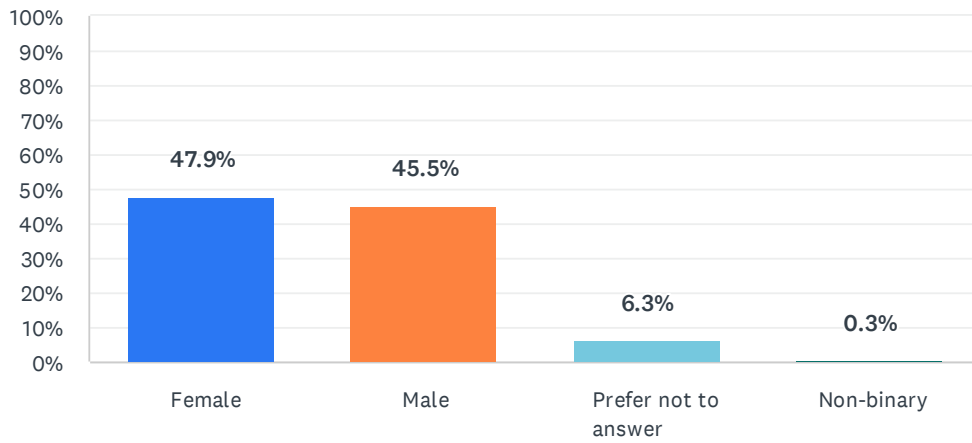

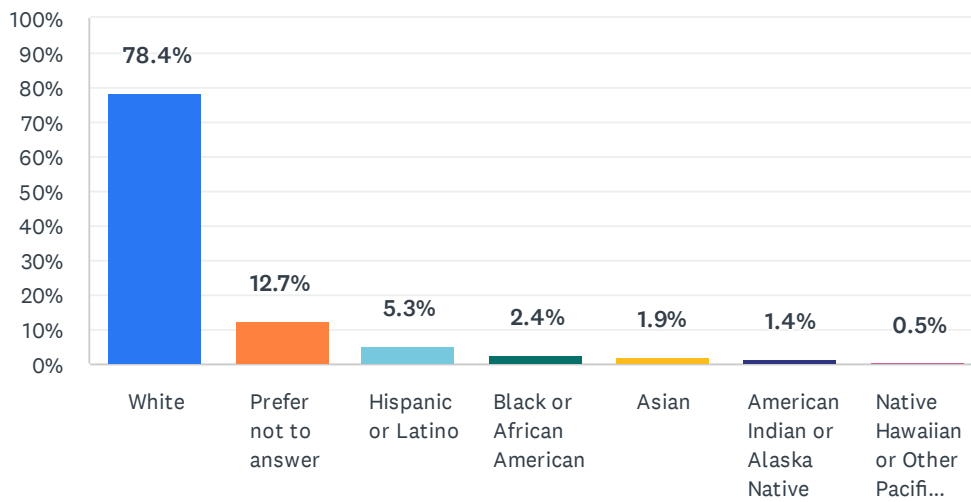

Q24 How would you describe yourself? Check all that apply. (optional)

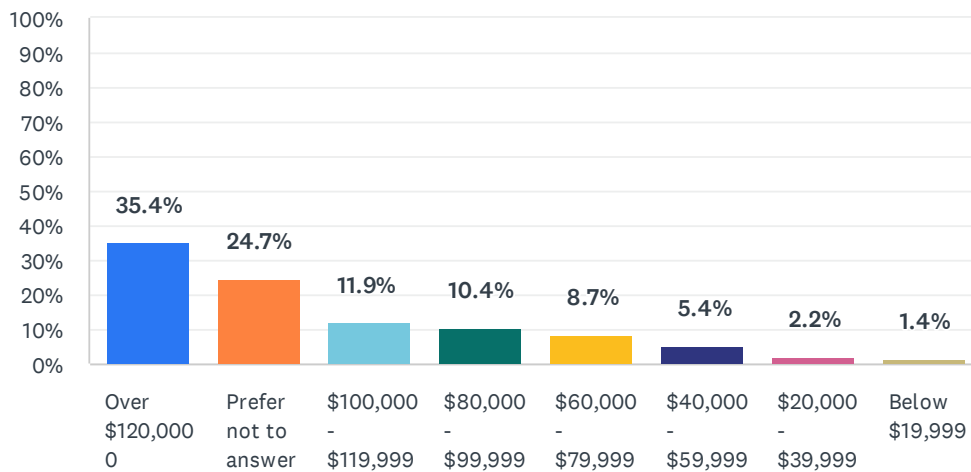
